### **Subcommittee Reports:**

- **Website – Bob Hallowell** reviewed the status of the site. Minimal content, questioned a link to the City's website. Concerns: security and access - need a city employee to "approve" content. Bob has bought \$ the domain name. John (IT) to authorize a link to the site from Nashua's website and to highlight "Go Green" month.
- **Energy Conservation Trust Fund** – Ms. Tremblay updated the committee regarding the approval by the Board of Aldermen on Tuesday, June 12, 2007 of the resolution that created the trust fund and the placement of the \$20,000 into the fund. Ms. Tremblay noted a second resolution is in process to place an additional \$5,000 into the fund, this is in committee. Rules of accessing and using the fund is a work in progress. There is one prospective applicant waiting to sign up.
- **Energy Fair 2007**– The change of location to Greeley Park was noted.
- **March to Re-Energize New Hampshire**- *The walk is planned to begin at City Hall at 9:30 AM on August 1 and end with a rally in Concord on August 5.*
- **Go Green Month**- *Working on a mayoral proclamation, Suggestion was to have a "tip of the day" Sally, Cassie, & Bob to work up 31 topics for each day in August. Looking for candidates to award recognition to on AUG 16. Janice to collect names of businesses, schools & organizations to be recognized with a "green ribbon" award from the Green Team*
- **Logo contest** –*As the schools are on summer break, no work is being done on the contest. The group suggested that this be a competition between all schools.*
- **Public Education and Outreach** – no report
- **GoGreen Month**-Angie Vincent suggested we look at a list of events for the month. Suggestion of a bike day, electronic recycling event at the landfill and the HHW collection at streets is highlighted.
